PROPOSAL: Set Public Hearings September 6, 2024 to Consider Adoption of and/or Amendments to South Coast AQMD Rules and Regulations:

<u>Determine That Proposed Rule 1165 – Control of Emissions from</u> <u>Municipal Solid Waste Incinerators, Is Exempt from CEQA and Adopt</u> <u>Rule 1165</u>

Proposed Rule 1165 (PR 1165) establishes NOx, PM, and CO emission limits from municipal solid waste incinerators. Additionally, PR 1165 will include provisions for housekeeping, monitoring, reporting, and recordkeeping. This action is to adopt the Resolution: 1) Determining that the Proposed Rule 1165 – Control of Emissions from Municipal Solid Waste Incinerators, is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act, and 2) Adopting Rule 1165 – Control of Emissions from Municipal Solid Waste Incinerators.
