Railroad Class/Type	Maximum Award Amount For All Project Types
Class 1*	75%
Class 2	75%
Class 3 and Passenger, military and industrial	85%



^{*} Class 1 projects will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. In addition, Class 1 co-funding with the Prop 1B Program is not allowed. Additional limitations may apply.

Eligible Projects



Repower

Baseline locomotive engines must be destroyed

Replacement


 Chassis may be reused if it is repowered to a Tier 4 or cleaner

Head End Power Unit (HEP)

- Baseline must be certified to off-road standard at time of manufacture
- New HEP must be certified to EPA Tier 4 final or cleaner



Requirements



- New engine must be EPA certified and ARB verified Tier 4 (or cleaner)
- Participant must have owned the current locomotive for at least a year
- Engine activity based on fuel consumption
- Cannot use Moyer Program funds to pay for labor or parts used during routine maintenance
- Annual reports will be required up to a maximum of 15 years or the life of the project/contract term
