



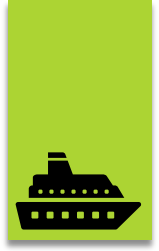

Eligible Projects & Funding Opportunities

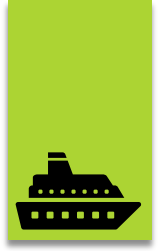
Ship-side shore power projects cover costs to retrofit to plug into shore power and install transformers for marine vessels



Eligible Costs	Ineligible Costs
Ship-side costs	Energy costs (fuel or electricity)
Up to 100% for on-board retrofit costs to plug into shore power	Shore power routine maintenance
Up to 50% of any necessary transformer costs on-board the vessel	Labor costs for connection and disconnection of the vessel

Project Criteria

- ▶ Cannot be co-funded with Prop 1B Goods Movement Program funds
- ▶ Ship-side project must be on vessels that are NOT subject to the Shore Power Regulation
- ▶ Limited funding opportunities for Shore-side Power Projects

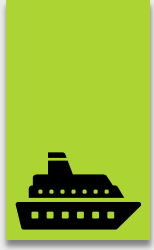
