Eligible Projects & Funding Opportunities

Ship-side shore power projects cover costs to retrofit to plug into shore power and install transformers for marine vessels

Eligible Costs Ineligible Costs Ship-side costs Energy costs (fuel or electricity) Up to 100% for onboard retrofit costs to Shore power routine plug into shore power maintenance Labor costs for Up to 50% of any necessary transformer connection and costs on-board the disconnection of vessel the vessel



Project Criteria

- Cannot be co-funded with Prop 1B Goods Movement Program funds
- Ship-side project must be on vessels that are NOT subject to the Shore Power Regulation
- Limited funding opportunities for Shore-side Power Projects
