**Draft Mitigated Negative Declaration (Draft MND) for the Proposed  
17000 W Rinaldi St; Granada Hills-Knollwood (ENV-2015-3452)**

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) staff appreciates the opportunity to comment on the above-mentioned document. The following comments are meant as guidance for the Lead Agency and should be incorporated into the Final MND.

The Lead Agency proposes to develop a 24 hour convenience store. The existing gasoline service station and underground storage tanks would be demolished and abandoned in place. Since the project includes demolition and tank removal, the Lead Agency should discuss and provide additional information regarding compliance with SCAQMD Rule 1166 – Volatile Organic Compound Emissions from Decontamination of Soil, and SCAQMD Rule 1149 – Storage Tank and Pipeline Cleaning and Degassing in the Final MND.

The SCAQMD staff is available to work with the Lead Agency to address these concerns and any other air quality questions that may arise.
