Class 1 Permit Modification for DeMenno-Kerdoon

South Coast Air Quality Management District (South Coast AQMD) staff appreciates the opportunity to provide comments on the above-mentioned document. DeMenno-Kerdoon (Facility) is requesting the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) to approve modifications to the Facility's existing hazardous waste facility permit to accept recycled and/or exempt oil and mix them with used and/or waste oil for storage and treatment and associated operation and management standards.

DeMenno-Kerdoon is a South Coast AQMD permitted Facility (Facility ID No. 800037) that is located at 2000 North Alameda Street in the City of Compton. Changing the materials added to the tanks at DeMenno-Kerdoon might be in conflict with any South Coast AQMD permit conditions for said tanks, and may also result in changes to the South Coast AQMD permit description for the Facility as well as any connected vapor control equipment. The proposed changes to the Facility's hazardous waste facility permit should be reviewed by South Coast AQMD Engineering and Permitting staff. Therefore, it is recommended that the DTSC initiate consultation with South Coast AQMD by contacting Mr. Thomas Liebel, Senior Air Quality Engineering Manager, at (909) 396-2554.
