**Project Description:** The 2003 AQMP includes short-term and long-term control measures for stationary

and mobile sources to be implemented by a cooperative partnership of governmental agencies at the federal, state, regional and local levels to achieve federal and state ambient air quality standards in the region. The PEIR analyzed environmental impacts to the following environmental topics: air quality; energy; hazards and hazardous material; hydrology and water quality; and solid/hazardous waste. It was concluded that implementing the 2003 AQMP could generate significant adverse

secondary impacts to air quality and hazards/hazardous materials.

This is to advise that the *South Coast Air Quality Management District* has approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the above described project:
