General Rules that Apply to Greenwaste & Composting Facilities

- AQMD Rules & Regulations and California Health & Safety (H&S) Code
 - Rule 201/203 – Permit to Construct/Permit to Operate
 - Rule 401/H&S 41701 – Visible Emissions
 - Rule 402/ H&S 41700 – Nuisance
 - Rule 403 – Fugitive Dust
 - Rule 461 – Gasoline Transfer and Dispensing
 - Statewide Portable Equipment Registration Program (PERP)

Rule 201/203 – Permit to Construct/ Permit to Operate

- Stationary/portable chippers/grinders
- Conveying equipment
- Screening equipment
- Gasoline storage tanks

General Rules that Apply to Greenwaste/Compost Facilities

- Rule 401 – Visible Emissions
 - H&S Code 41701
 - Limits opacity to 20% for 3 minutes
- Rule 402
 - H&S Code Section 41700
 - Composting Permit from LEA: LEA handles odor complaints: H&S Section 41705

General Rules that Apply to Greenwaste/Compost Facilities

- AQMD Rule 403 – Fugitive Dust
 - Prohibits dust visibly crossing a property line
 - Prohibits dust > 20% opacity
 - Prohibits trackout > 25 feet; clean at the end of the day



General Rules that Apply to Greenwaste/Compost Facilities

- Rule 461 – Gasoline Transfer and Dispensing
 - Storage Tank and Transfer – Phase I
 - Dispensing – Phase II
 - CARB Certification
 - Testing, Reporting and Recordkeeping
